

Homemade Cherry Cobbler

Ingredients: For the filling-

- 2 cans of Cherries
- 1/2 cup sugar granulated
- 2 tablespoon cornstarch
- 2 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1/8 teaspoon salt For the Crust-
- 1 cup all purpose flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg
- 3/4 cup milk
- 1/2 cup butter unsalted, melted, for the skillet

Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 375 F degrees.
- Cook the cherries in a saucepan with the rest of the filling ingredients.
 Cook them over medium heat for about 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- Make the batter: Mix the flour, sugar, baking powder, salt, egg, and milk in a bowl until smooth.

 Melt the butter in the skillet, remove from heat, then pour the batter in.
- Bake: Spoon the cherry mixture in an even layer over the batter and turn the oven down to 350F. Bake for 40 to 45 minutes, or until golden brown.
